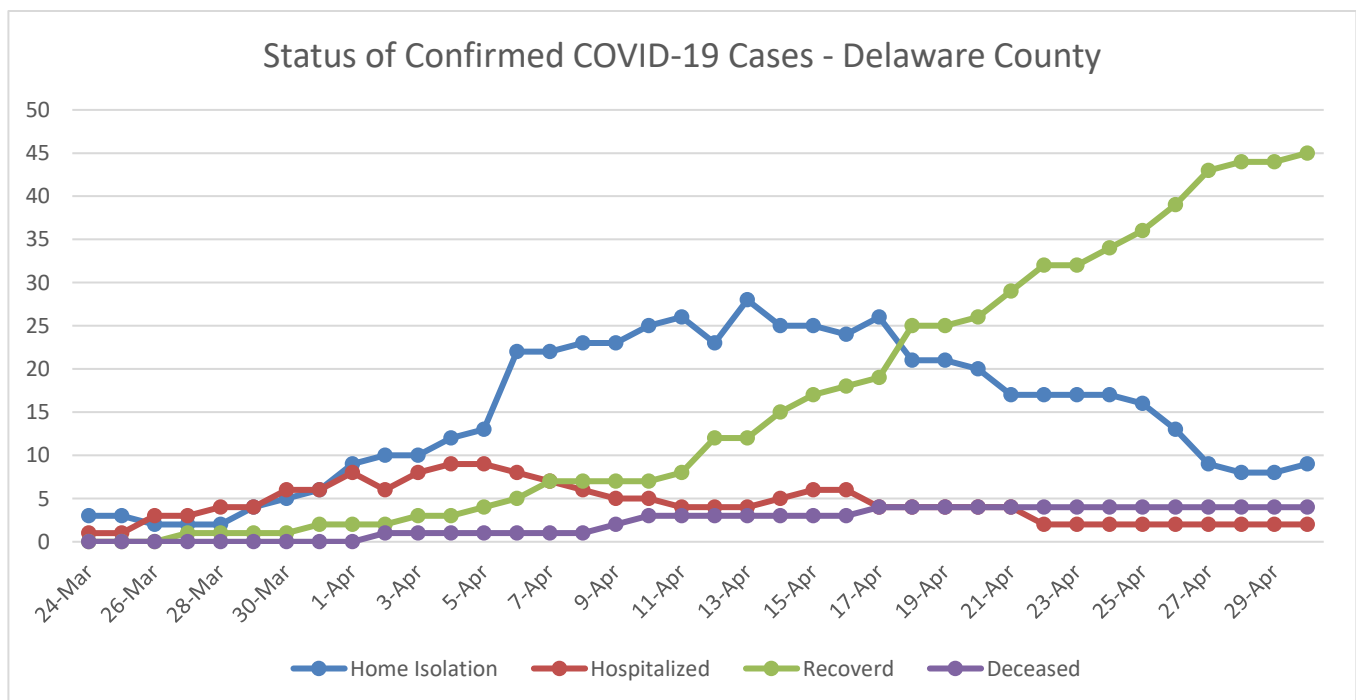

### PRESS RELEASE April 30, 2020

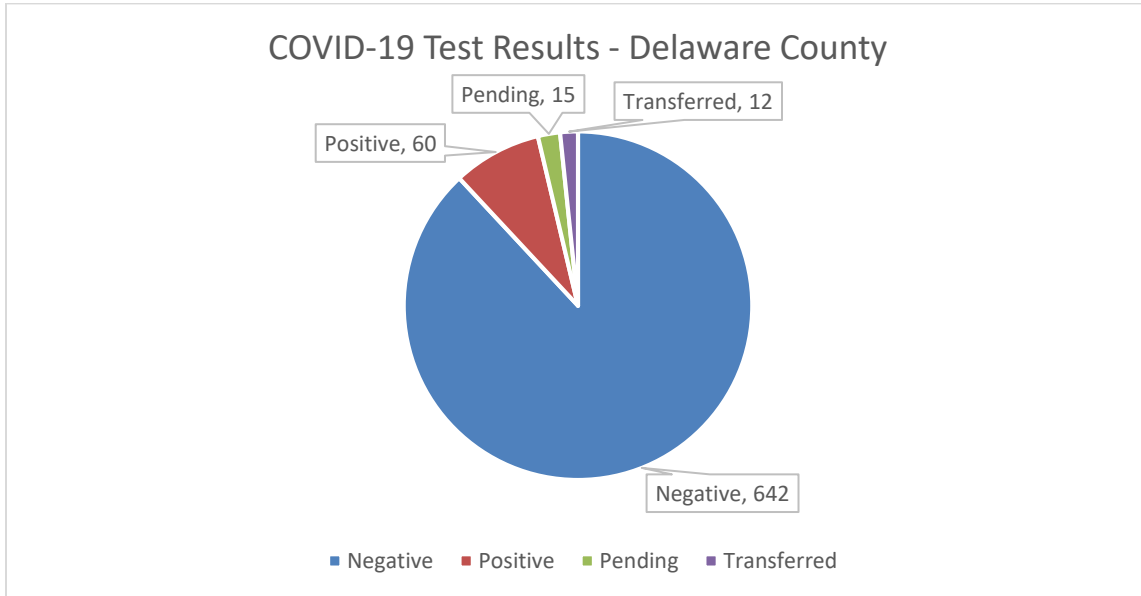
Delaware County is reporting two new cases of COVID-19 today. In addition, one more person has been discharged from care. This means with the increasing number of recoveries in relationship to the limited number of new cases in Delaware County there remains only 11 known active cases in the county.

To date there have been 72 confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 reported to Delaware County. There are an additional 25 people under mandatory quarantine and no people under precautionary quarantine. To date 730 people have been tested. Of those 642 results are negative and we are still waiting for results from 15 tests. Twelve (12) confirmed cases have been transferred out of the county. Of the 60 confirmed positive cases in Delaware County 2 are isolated and receiving medical care in a hospital, 9 are isolated and recovering safely at their homes, 4 people are deceased and 45 have fully recovered and are no longer in isolation. It is important to note confirmed cases does not mean the total number of potential cases in the County. Access to testing remains extremely limited, the number of confirmed cases does not reflect the current spread of COVID-19.

The following chart is a representation of positive cases since March 23, 2020.



The following pie chart illustrates the amount of testing and the results reported:



The following chart represents the total number of confirmed cases reported to Delaware County in relationship to the number of those cases that have been transferred, discharged from care, deceased and active cases of the disease. The number of known active cases as of today is 11, the number transferred is 12 and the number discharged is 45 while the number deceased remains 4.
