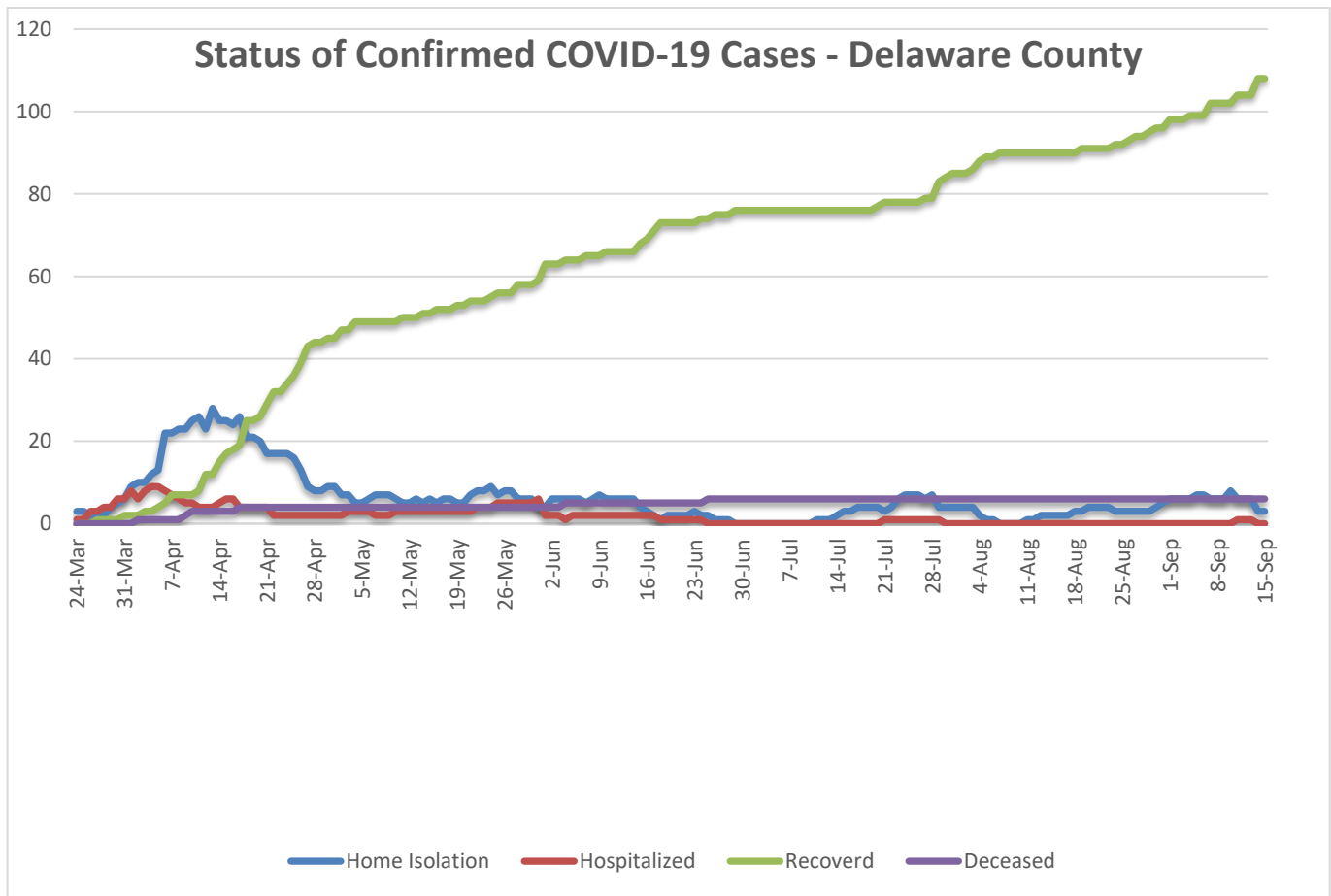
### **PRESS RELEASE September 15, 2020**

Delaware County is reporting no new positive test result for COVID-19 and no additional recoveries. The known active cases in the County as of today remains 3. To date there have been 117 confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 in Delaware County, with 61 people now under mandatory quarantine and no one under precautionary quarantine. As of today 3 people are isolated and receiving care at home and no one is isolated in the hospital, 6 people have died and 108 have fully recovered and are no longer isolated or receiving care.

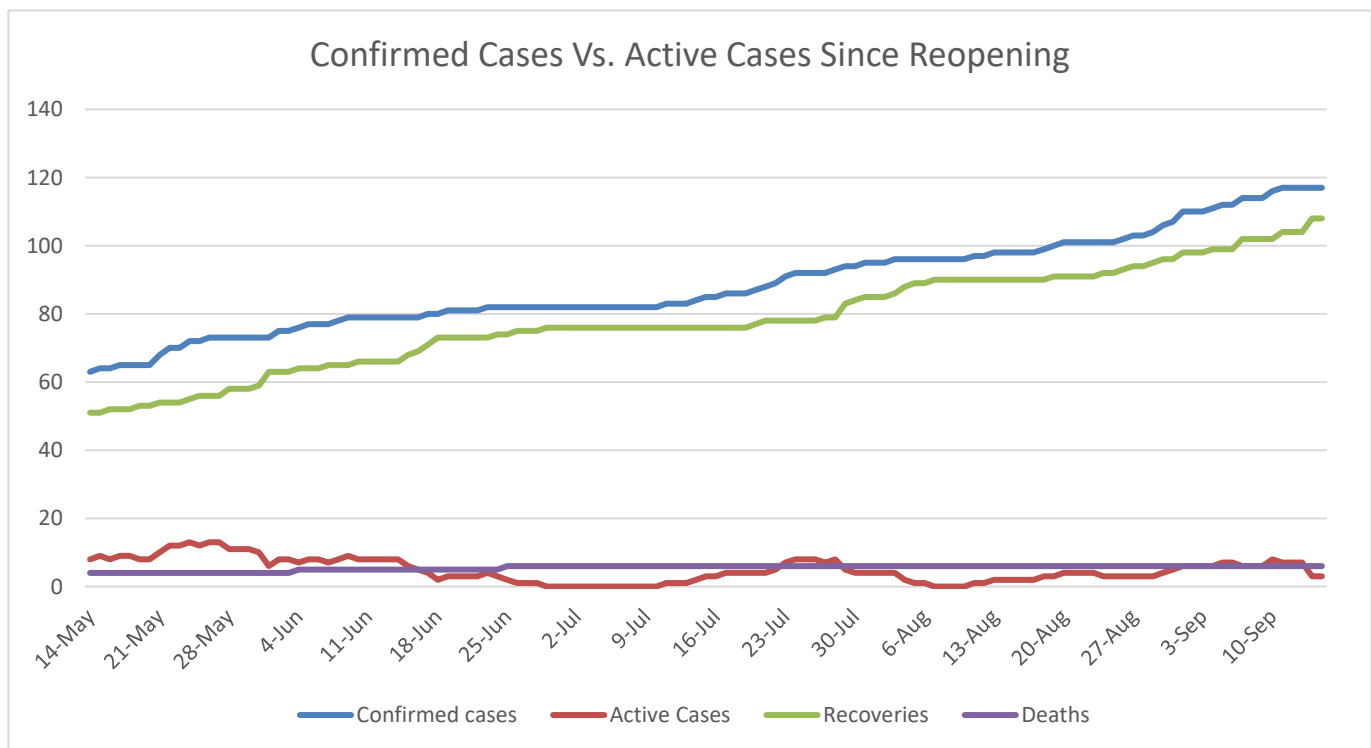
Today Governor Cuomo addressed a rumor that he is cancelling Halloween. Today he announced that he is not planning a state wide ban on Halloween, Trick or Treating or other Halloween activities. He is asking that families practice safe trick or treating and will possibly provide some guidance on best practices to keep families safe. The state has already released guidance for fall activities including hay rides, corn mazes, haunted houses and pumpkin picking. New York continues to see low infection rates of less than 1%, however some hot spots that have been identified are of concern. It is important to remain vigilant and practice social distancing, practice good hand washing and wear face coverings in public.

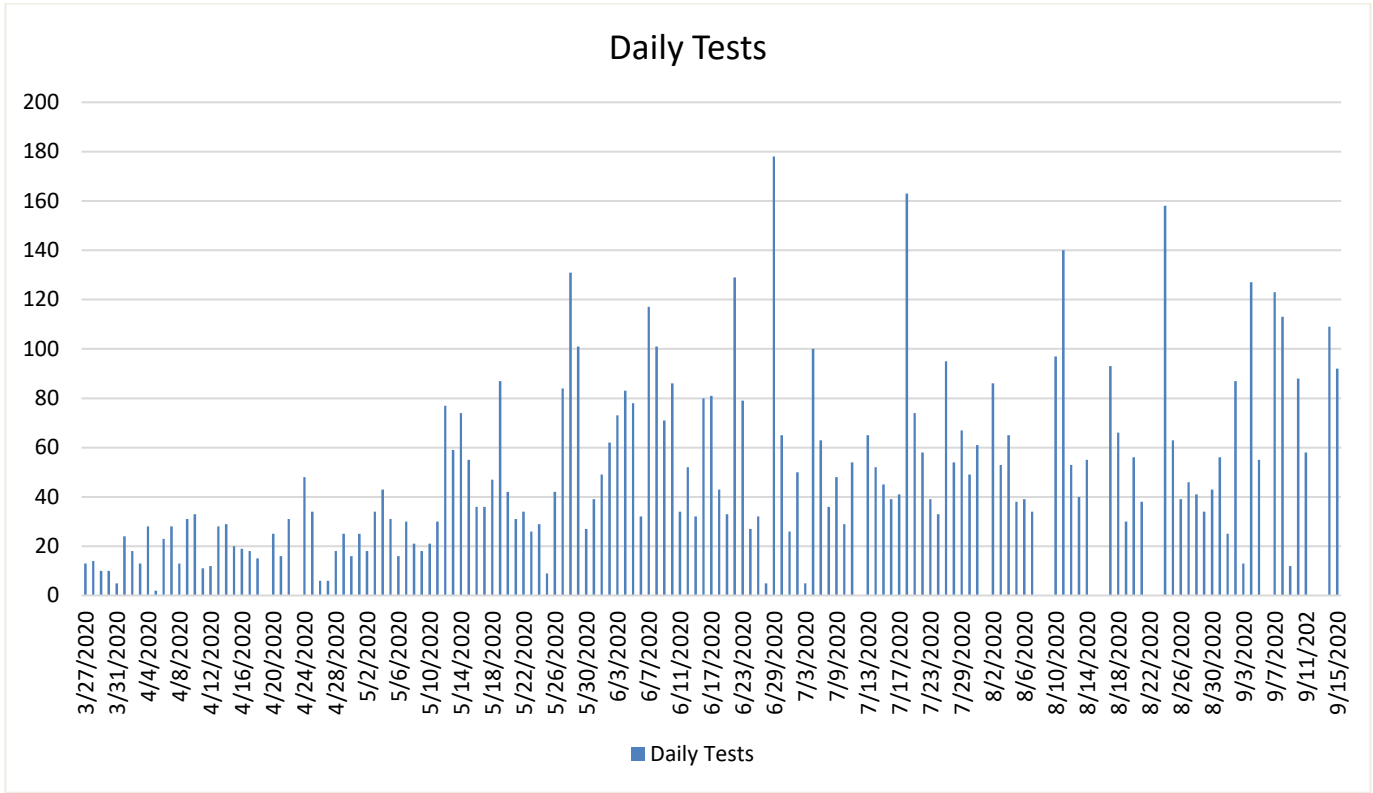
The following chart is a representation of positive cases since March 23, 2020.



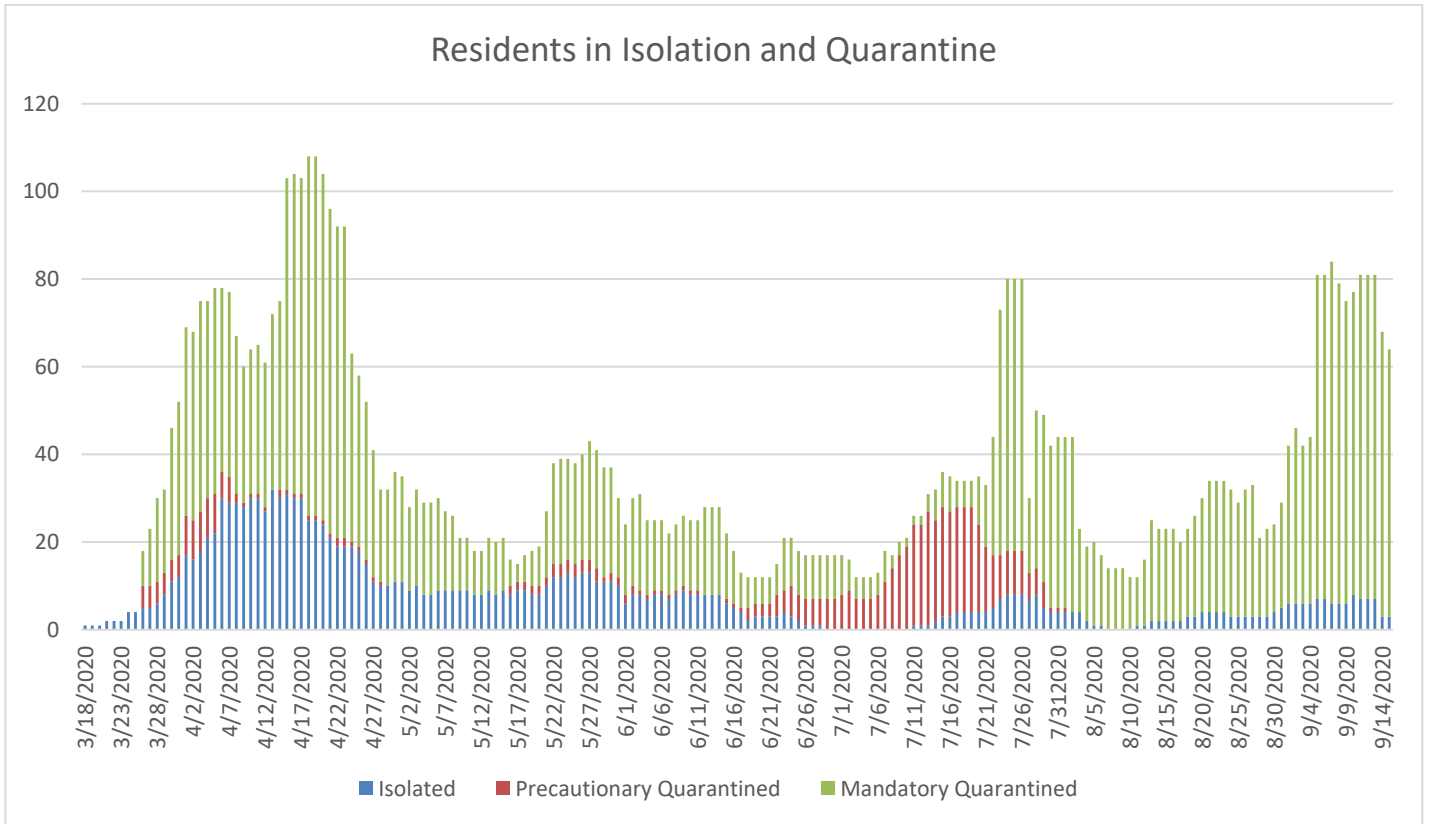
The following chart represents the number of cases since the beginning of our economic reopening Phase 1 on May 15, 2020. The numbers have remained fairly consistent with confirmed cases and recoveries rising slowly, keeping the number of active cases and deaths flat from day to day.



Delaware County remains vigilant in testing residents. The following chart represents the total number of new daily test results received since March 26, 2020.



Another important measure that we need to be conscious of are the residents that have been placed under mandatory or precautionary quarantine. The following chart shows the number of residents quarantined and isolated.



The following chart represents the total number of confirmed cases in Delaware County in relationship to the number of those cases that have been discharged from care, deceased and active cases of the disease. The number of known active cases as of today is 3 and the number discharged is 108 while the number deceased is 6.
