### **PRESS RELEASE October 2, 2020**

Delaware County is saddened to report that there has been an 8<sup>th</sup> person with COVID-19 that has died. We send our deepest condolences to the family and friends. We ask that all residents continue to social distance as COVID-19 remains a threat in Delaware County.

Delaware County is reporting three (3) new cases of COVID-19 today. The known active cases in the County as of today is now 6. To date there have been 126 confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 in Delaware County, with 53 people now under mandatory quarantine and no one under precautionary quarantine. As of today six (6) people are isolated and receiving care at home and no one is isolated in the hospital, 8 people have died and 112 have fully recovered and are no longer isolated or receiving care.

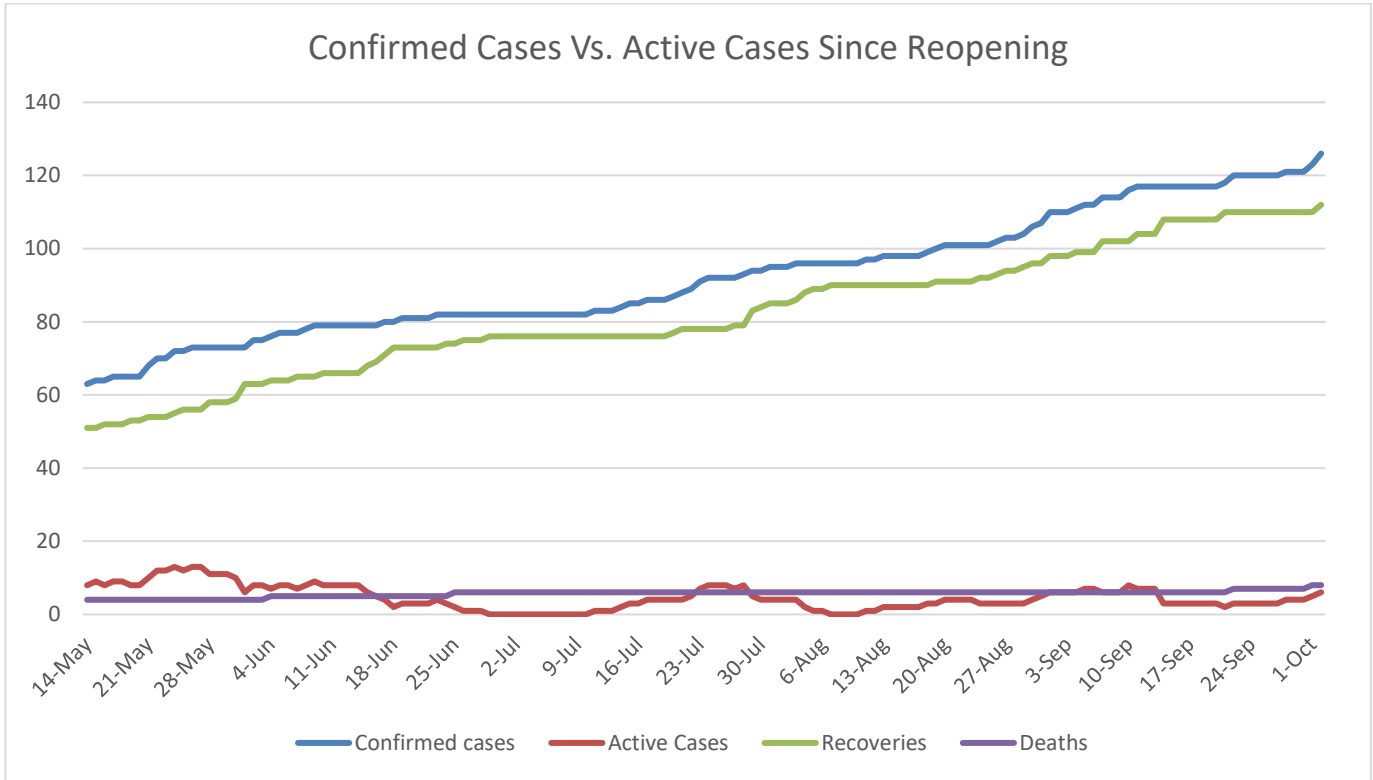

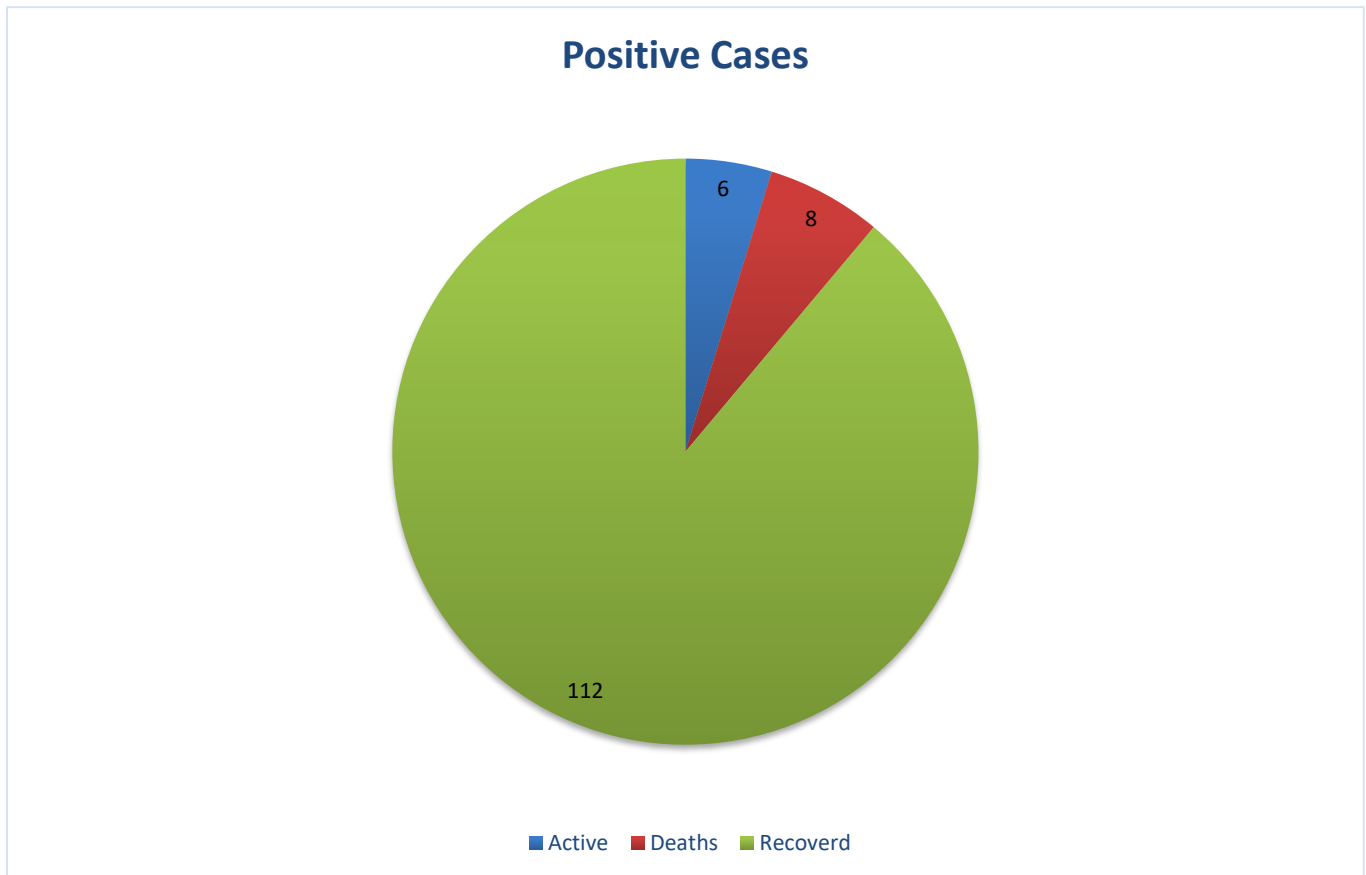

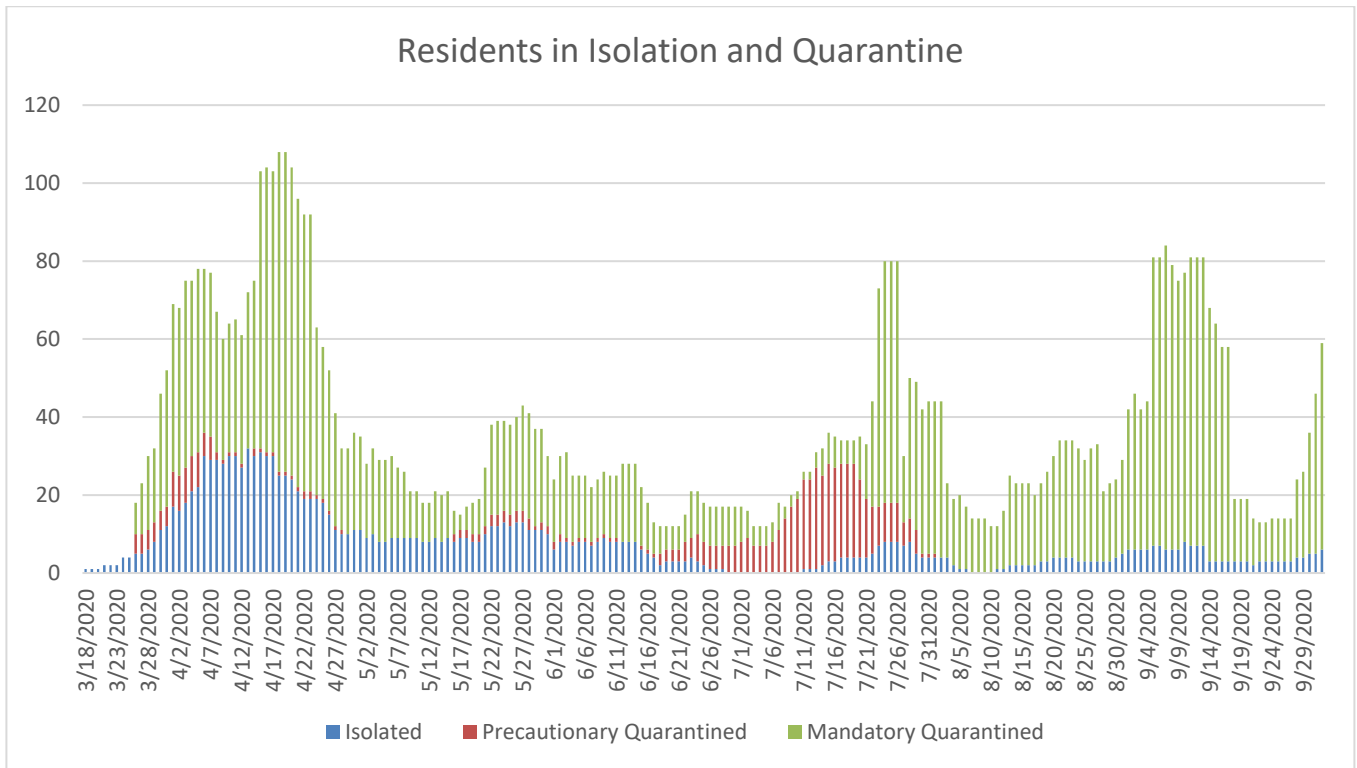
The following chart represents the number of cases since the beginning of our economic reopening Phase 1 on May 15, 2020.
