DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for the efficient performance of cleaning tasks under general supervision. Employees in this class receive thorough and detailed instructions regarding work assignments. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only) Dusts chairs, tables, desks and other furniture; Washes windows, walls, woodwork, water closets, tubs and bowls; Sweeps, mops and washes floor; Gathers and disposes of refuse; Cleans and polishes furniture and metal furnishings.

FULL PERFORMANCE, KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Some knowledge of cleaning methods, and equipment; Ability to understand and follow simple oral and written directions; Ability to get along well with others; thoroughness; Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: None are required.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS: In accordance with the Safe Schools Against Violence in Education (SAVE) legislation, Chapter 180 of the Laws of 2000, and by the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education, candidates for appointment in school districts must obtain clearance for employment from the State Education Department prior to employment based upon a fingerprint and criminal history background check.
